Congratulations! We are very pleased to inform you, informally at this point, that you have been selected for admission to the **LLM in International Arbitration & Dispute Resolution**, in Academic year 2021/22, starting in August 2021.

An official admission offer letter (including details of your course curriculum, immigration matters...etc) shall be emailed to you in May 2021, if you agree to be in the mailing list to receive the admission offer letter. Please note that in response to the public health situation arising from COVID-19, there currently are (and may continue to be) immigration restrictions or quarantine measures affecting travel to Singapore. You will be required to comply with these measures. Given that this is a rapidly developing situation, we strongly urge you to refer to the immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) website at www.ica.gov.sg/news-and-publications/public-education/updates-on-border-control-measures for the most up-to-date information on these measures and to take them into account as you plan your travel to Singapore.

In general, classes are currently conducted in hybrid mode. For modules with no more than 50 students, students may attend classes in person with safe distancing measures in place, while online classes may be conducted for modules with larger enrolment and for international students who are unable to travel to Singapore due to safety measures arising from the pandemic situation. We regret that we are not able to advise on class arrangements for the next intake at this juncture as it would depend on the safe management measures close to that period. However, international students are encouraged to join us in Singapore for their studies, where permissible.
